It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 6-13.1 of the General Laws entitled "Deceptive Trade Practices" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>6-13.1-12.2. Appliance manufacturer mandatory retailer return. -- Any appliance</u>
- 4 <u>manufacturer that sells their appliances to a Rhode Island wholesaler or retailer sales outlet shall</u>
- 5 grant a full price sales credit for any appliance that is returned to it unused, within a reasonable
- 6 time. It is the expressed public policy of this state that the appliance consumer not be financially
- 7 <u>damaged if they return unused appliances with a reasonable time of sale.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
