It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16-40-10.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-40 entitled "Private 2 Schools" is hereby repealed.

3 16-40-10.1. Katharine Gibbs School. -- Notwithstanding any rule, regulation or general

4 law to the contrary, the Katharine Gibbs School shall be authorized to grant associate degrees

provided that it is in compliance with the regulations and standards for approval adopted by the 5

board of regents for elementary and secondary education or the board of governors for higher 6

7 education, as appropriate.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO EDUCATION -- PRIVATE SCHOOLS

This act would repeal section 16-40-10.1 which authorizes the Katharine Gibbs School to
grant associate degrees. With the approval of the Board of Governors for Higher Education, the
Katharine Gibbs School, currently a degree-granting proprietary institution, has acted to change
its business name and operating status to Sanford-Brown Institute, a non-degree granting
proprietary school, which would offer only certificate programs.

This act would take effect upon passage.
