1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-10.1 of the General Laws entitled "Special License for

Motorcycles, Motor Scooters, and Other Motor Driven Cycles" is hereby amended by adding

3 thereto the following section:

31-10.1-1.3. Motorcycle education courses - landowner immunity from civil liability.

5 <u>Any landowner, who allows their private property to be used, whether or not for a fee, as an</u>

6 <u>instructional educational course for a certified motorcycle driver education program shall not be</u>

7 <u>liable for any personal injury, wrongful death, property damage, or other loss or damage that may</u>

8 occur during the course of instruction or training. The immunity granted by this section shall not

9 apply to willful or malicious failure to warn against a known dangerous condition, use, structure

10 <u>or activity.</u>
