- 5 No interpreter/transliterator appointed pursuant to this chapter to interpret or translate for
- 6 <u>limited-English-proficient persons in proceedings before the state courts in Rhode Island shall be</u>
- 7 <u>called upon to testify concerning any statement(s) made to them in connection with the</u>
- 8 interpreter's or transliterator's interpretation or transliteration without the consent of the person
- 9 <u>making the statement or unless compelled by court order.</u>
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
