It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-6-18 of the General Laws in Chapter 36-6 entitled "Salaries and
2 Traveling Expenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **36-6-18. Additional vacation time for career state employees.** -- (a) State employees,
4 classified, nonclassified, or unclassified, who have been in the service of the state for at least
5 twenty (20) years shall be credited annually with five (5) days additional vacation time.

6 ~~-(b) All state employees may have prior service time with a state of Rhode Island~~
7 ~~municipality credited to their present state service for the purpose of computing vacation accrual~~
8 ~~under the provisions of this section.~~

9 ~~-(c) All state employees may have prior service time including service as an elected~~
10 ~~official with a state municipality credited to their present state service for the purpose of~~
11 ~~computing vacation accrual under the provisions of this section.~~

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
