1 WHEREAS, There exists a correlation between adequate child nutrition and a child's
2 physical, emotional, and cognitive development, as well as a direct relationship between adequate
3 nutrition and a child's ability to perform well in school; now, therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
5 Providence Plantations hereby supports and encourages the expansion of the Universal School
6 Breakfast Program, including, but not limited to, pilot programs that provide a Universal School
7 Breakfast in the classroom, regardless of family income; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and he hereby is authorized and directed to
9 transmit duly certified copies of this resolution to the Rhode Island Board of Regents, the Rhode
10 Island Commissioner of Elementary and Secondary Education, the National Education
11 Association of Rhode Island, and the Rhode Island Federation of Teachers and Health
