It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11-47 of the General Laws entitled "Weapons" is hereby amended
- 2 by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>11-47-51.2. Discharge of firearm or incendiary or explosive substance or device at</u>
- 4 <u>empty dwelling, building, ship, automobile or other conveyance.</u>
- 5 (a) No person shall unlawfully discharge a firearm or incendiary or explosive substance or
- 6 device with the intent to hit or fire into any unoccupied dwelling, building, other structure or ship,
- 7 <u>automobile or other conveyance.</u>
- 8 (b) Every person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by imprisonment
- 9 for not more than ten (10) years and shall be fined not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or
- 10 <u>both.</u>
- 11 (c) Any person injured as a result of a violation of this section shall be entitled to the civil
- 12 remedies provided by § 7-15-4.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
