It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 38-2-3.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 38-2 entitled "Access to
- 2 Public Records" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **38-2-3.1. Records required.**
- 4 (a) All records required to be maintained pursuant to this chapter shall not be replaced or
- 5 supplemented with the product of a "real-time translation reporter".
- 6 (b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, all electronic data which must
- 7 <u>be retained to comply with the requirements of this chapter, shall be converted into a form which</u>
- 8 is readily and easily retrievable by government officials in order to enable them to comply with a
- 9 records request made pursuant to this chapter.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
