CONGRATULATING THE PORTSMOUTH BOYS HOCKEY TEAM ON WINNING THE 2010 RHODE ISLAND DIVISION II HOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP

In the second game, Aaron Towers and Ben Peckham scored goals 5 eighteen seconds apart to give Portsmouth a 2-0 lead.
