**CONGRATULATING THE PORTSMOUTH BOYS HOCKEY TEAM ON WINNING THE
2010 RHODE ISLAND DIVISION II HOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP**

1 WHEREAS, The Portsmouth Boys Hockey Team completed a two-game sweep of
2 Cumberland in the Rhode Island Division II state championship series to win the state
3 championship, their first in eight years and second in the fifteen-year history of the program; and

4 WHEREAS, Portsmouth won the first game of the championship series 3-2 in a thrilling
5 game decided in overtime. In the second game, Aaron Towers and Ben Peckham scored goals
6 eighteen seconds apart to give Portsmouth a 2-0 lead. Aside from allowing one goal, goaltender
7 Cory Martin shut down the Cumberland attack and Can Harrigan's empty net goal at 14:31 in the
8 final period sealed the game and the state championship for Portsmouth; and

9 WHEREAS, Portsmouth was led all season by the innovative leadership provided by
10 Head Coach Mike Monohan, and was encouraged by Portsmouth fans and supporters whose
11 passionate support ranks second-to-none in Rhode Island state athletics; now, therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
13 Providence Plantations hereby congratulates the Portsmouth Boys Hockey Team on winning the
14 2010 Rhode Island Division II Hockey Championship; and be it further
