 caused by COVID-19, § 23-17.5-33 shall be suspended.

 (b) Unless extended by the general assembly, § 23-17.5-33.1, shall sunset on June 30, 2022,
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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- RIGHTS OF NURSING HOME PATIENTS

This act would, due to the COVID-19 health crises, suspend the provisions of § 23-17.533, relating to nursing home staffing and unless extended by the general assembly, the suspension
would sunset on June 30, 2022 at which time the provisions of § 23-17.5-33 would be restored.

This act would take effect upon passage.
