SECTION 1. Chapter 23-28.2 of the General Laws entitled "Office of State Fire Marshal"

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2	is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	23-28.2-30. Task force to study PFAS in firefighter gear.
4	(a) There shall be established a task force to study the presence of PFAS in firefighter gear.
5	This task force at a minimum shall include:
6	(1) The director of the department of environmental management, or designee;
7	(2) The director of the department of health, or designee;
8	(3) The director of the emergency management agency, or designee;
9	(4) The president of the executive board of the Rhode Island Association of Fire Chiefs, or
10	designee; and
11	(5) The director of the Rhode Island State Association of Fire Fighters, or designee.
12	(b) The task force shall study the issue of PFAS in firefighter gear, monitor the
13	development of alternatives to this gear, develop a timeline for replacing gear statewide, and
14	develop a strategy for funding the replacement gear from state or federal funds.
15	(c) The task force shall advise the general assembly and the governor of the task force's
16	findings and strategy no later than January 1, 2024.
17	(d) The provisions of this section shall sunset on July 1, 2024.
