1           WHEREAS, Representative Serodio is a graduate of East Providence High School and is  
2 employed as the President and General Partner of America Travel. He makes his home in the  
3 City of East Providence with his wife, Ana; and

4           WHEREAS, Elected in November of 2018, the Honorable Jose Serodio has served with  
5 honor in the Rhode Island House of Representatives, District 64, for the past two years,  
6 representing the citizens of the City of East Providence. He is a member of the House Committee  
7 on Health, Education and Welfare, the House Committee on Corporations, and the House  
8 Committee on Small Business; and

9           WHEREAS, During his tenure in the House, Representative Serodio has been  
10 instrumental in sponsoring and supporting numerous pieces of legislation including bills to  
11 protect seniors and qualified disabled adults from financial exploitation, and an act that requires  
12 private and public schools to provide and maintain opioid antagonists (Narcan) on-site. In  
13 addition, he sponsored legislation that would provide an income tax credit to senior taxpayers  
14 who pay a water or sewer bill on their primary residence; and

15           WHEREAS, Representative Serodio's civic and community involvement includes  
16 membership in numerous local and professional groups including, the Holy Ghost Beneficial  
17 Brotherhood and the Holy Ghost Brotherhood of Charity in East Providence, and founding  
18 member of the East Providence Soccer Club. Proud of his Portuguese heritage, he is a past  
19 President of the East Providence Portuguese School, and a past board member of the Portuguese-

1 American Scholarship Foundation and the Portuguese American Business Association; and

2 WHEREAS, Representative Serodio's devotion to the citizens of the Ocean State has  
3 earned him our unqualified admiration and respect, and he will assuredly be missed; now,
