It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 23-27.3 of the General Laws entitled "State Building Code" is
 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 23-27.3-702. Short-term rentals Code exemptions.
- 4 (a) Notwithstanding any general law, special law, public law, rule or regulation, building
- 5 code or fire safety code, or any existing residential dwelling unit, including, but not limited to, a
- 6 single family residence, apartment, condominium, or cooperative unit, which provides sleeping
- 7 accommodations for less than thirty (30) days, shall not be subject to:
- 8 (1) Any provision that mandates the compliance with the Rhode Island fire safety code
- 9 beyond the requirement for smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms pursuant to chapter 28.1
- 10 <u>of title 23.</u>
- 11 (2) Any provision that mandates the compliance with accessibility requirements to which
- 12 places of public accommodations are subject to, including, but not limited to, those standards
- 13 required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

- 1 This act would exempt existing residential dwelling units from the requirements of the
- 2 fire safety code and accessibility standards set by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
- 3 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
