CONGRATULATING MASTER SERGEANT STEPHEN F. KILMARTIN ON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES ARMY RESERVE AFTER FORTY YEARS OF HONORABLE, DISTINGUISHED, AND DEDICATED SERVICE TO OUR NATION

1 WHEREAS, Throughout America's history, this nation has been propitiously blessed 2 with so many of its citizenry willing to protect the precious freedoms and liberties on which this 3 great country was founded. Stephen F. Kilmartin fully embodies this noble tradition of service; 4 and

5 WHEREAS, In 1970, Master Sergeant Kilmartin enlisted in the United States Army. 6 Since then, he has served our nation with extraordinary loyalty, competence, distinction, and 7 dedication, in both the United States Army and United States Army Reserve. He has touched the 8 lives of countless soldiers who have benefitted not only from his mentorship and professional 9 support, but also from his compassion. His legacy is one of selfless devotion to safeguarding and 10 caring for the lives and needs of his fellow soldiers; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Kilmartin was responsible for the readiness transformation effort that resulted in increasing the strength of the 1st Brigade, improving overall soldier ratings, and more than doubling assigned instructor certifications. In addition, he handled over 3,000 personnel actions with the utmost care, thereby assuring timely and accurate results; and

WHEREAS, With formidable determination, Master Sergeant Kilmartin provided yearly personnel support for more than 400 soldiers assigned to the Brigade. His efforts resulted in the proper certification of instructors for the Brigade's S-1, which allowed the Brigade to fully carry out its assigned mission in support of the effort to win the war on global terrorism; and

19 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Kilmartin flawlessly performed the duties of the de facto

Brigade S-1 in the absence of one of the Senior NCO's. He fully supported the difficult but
 seamless integration of five MI Batallions into the Brigade, and was a vital component in the
 Brigade's transformation and realignment into the 100th Division in October of 2008; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Kilmartin's spirit, sacrifice, and commitment to the causes of democracy and freedom are immutable, and we are proud to commemorate and pay tribute to his distinguished military career; now, therefore be it
