It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-41.1-3.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-41.1 entitled
"Adjudication of Traffic Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>**31-41.1-3.1. Mandatory court appearances. --** (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of 4 sections 31-41.1-2 or 31-41.1-3, any person who receives a third (3rd) summons <u>after two (2)</u> 5 <u>guilty adjudications for traffic offenses</u> within a twelve (12) month period of time cannot plea or 6 dispose of the charge by mail, but must appear in person before a judge at the traffic tribunal or 7 municipal court. <u>All parking ticket summons or adjudications shall be exempt from this section.</u></u>

8 (b) The preceding twelve (12) month period shall be calculated from the date of the 9 issuance of the third (3rd) summons, after the preceding two (2) convictions.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
