It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21-31 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Food, Drugs, and
- 2 Cosmetics Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **21-31-25.** Fee limit on third-party food delivery services.
- 4 <u>During a state of emergency declared by the governor of the state of Rhode Island pursuant</u>
- 5 to chapter 15 of title 30 and for a period of ninety (90) days after the end of the declared state of
- 6 <u>emergency</u>, the maximum delivery fee to be charged by a third-party food delivery service shall be
- 7 <u>fifteen percent (15%).</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
