It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows： SECTION 1．Chapter 21－31 of the General Laws entitled＂Rhode Island Food，Drugs，and Cosmetics Act＂is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section： 21－31－25．Fee limit on third－party food delivery services．

During a state of emergency declared by the governor of the state of Rhode Island pursuant to chapter 15 of title 30 and for a period of ninety（90）days after the end of the declared state of emergency，the maximum delivery fee to be charged by a third－party food delivery service shall be fifteen percent（15\％）．

SECTION 2．This act shall take effect upon passage．
