COSMETICS ACT

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21-31 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Food, Drugs, and  
2 Cosmetics Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **21-31-25. Fee limit on third-party food delivery services.**

4 During a state of emergency declared by the governor of the state of Rhode Island pursuant  
5 to chapter 15 of title 30 and for a period of ninety (90) days after the end of the declared state of  
6 emergency, the maximum delivery fee to be charged by a third-party food delivery service shall be  
7 fifteen percent (15%).

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
