It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5-20.8-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-20.8 entitled "Real Estate
- 2 Sales Disclosures" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 5-20.8-5. Real estate disclosure form acknowledgement — Inclusion in real estate
- 4 sales agreements — Penalty for violation.
- 5 (a) Every agreement for the purchase and sale of residential real estate located in the state
- 6 shall contain an acknowledgement that a completed real estate disclosure form has been provided
- 7 to the buyer by the seller.
- 8 (b) Failure to provide the seller disclosure form to the buyer does not void the agreement
- 9 nor create any defect in title. Each violation of this statute by the seller or his or her agent is subject
- 10 to a maximum civil penalty in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100 1,000) per
- 11 occurrence.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO BUSINESSES AND PROFESSIONS -- REAL ESTATE SALES DISCLOSURES

This act would increase the civil penalty from one hundred dollars (\$100) to a maximum
of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), whenever a seller or their real estate agent fails to provide a
completed seller disclosure form to the buyer.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
