1	WHEREAS, The health and well-being of all children throughout our state are of
2	paramount importance to Rhode Island's families and communities; and
3	WHEREAS, Thousands of children are born with birth defects every year, including
4	approximately 40,000 children in the United States who begin life with one of more than thirty-
5	five identified forms of congenital heart defects; and
6	WHEREAS, Congenital heart defects are among our state's most common birth defects
7	and they are often fatal due to their seriousness, a lack of effective medical intervention options
8	and the limited availability of infant donor hearts; and
9	WHEREAS, The origins and symptoms of congenital heart defects are becoming more
10	readily identifiable and the range of surgical options are expanding continuously thanks to
11	doctors' and scientists' diligent research efforts and field experiences that extend our body of
12	knowledge every day; and
13	WHEREAS, There is much to learn about the causes of and effective treatments for
14	congenital heart defects, and it is important for parents, pediatricians, and nurses to recognize the
15	warning signs associated with congenital heart defects among newborns so they may provide
16	proper treatment as early as possible; and
17	WHEREAS, Many of Rhode Island's families and communities are directly or indirectly
18	affected by infant illness and death caused by congenital heart defects; now, therefore be it
19	RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations

- 1 hereby proclaims the week of February $7^h 14^{th}$ to be "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness
- Week" in our state. We furthermore urge all the citizens of the state to join us in the observance
- 3 of this week and to recognize and applaud the efforts of doctors and scientists everywhere who
- 4 work diligently to solve life's medical mysteries and to improve the quality of life for us all; and
