SECTION 1. Chapter 4-1 of the General Laws entitled "Cruelty to Animals" is hereby

2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>4-1-40. Possession of animals.</u> – (a) In addition to any other penalty imposed by law, a

4 person convicted of any misdemeanor violation under the provisions of this chapter shall not

5 possess or reside with any animal for a period five (5) years following entry of the conviction.

Any offense under this subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding one

7 thousand dollars (\$1,000) and forfeiture of the animal(s).

8 (b) In addition to any other penalty imposed by law, a person convicted of any felony

violation under the provisions of this chapter shall not possess or reside with an animal for a

period of fifteen (15) years following entry of the conviction. An offense under this subsection is

11 <u>a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and forfeiture of</u>
