He had also owned and operated G&M Construction and the Pascoag Realty and 13 Insurance Company; and 14 WHEREAS, As a avid sports fan, Mr. George was a passionate supporter of the Red Sox, the Celtics, and the New England Patriots; and 15 WHEREAS, Mr. George was also committed to serving his community and delighted in 16 17 being active in local politics. He had initiated the Burrillville Sewer Commission, for which he 18 was honored with the dedication of the facility in his name. For many years, he had served as the

Chairman on the Burrillville Democratic Town Committee, and he had been honored as a lifelong

member and Fourth Degree Knight of Columbus; and
