WHEREAS, The FIRST LEGO League (FLL) is a robotics program for 9 to 14 year olds 1 2 which is designed to get them excited about science and technology and to teach them valuable 3 employment and life skills; and WHEREAS, "Blockheads" team members Matthew Baker, Matthew Levin, Jared 4 Santerre, and Adam Santerre, who range in age from eight years old to ten years old, competed 5 for the very first time against many older and more experienced teams; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Attending meetings with MIT and Brown professors, competing in 8 scrimmages at New England Tech, conducting research interviews, and visiting a local 9 biomedical engineering company all served to focus and hone the team's skills; and 10 WHEREAS, On January 15, 2011, competing against 58 teams, consisting of over 500 11 young people, the "Blockheads" won the award for Best Overall Robot, one of the three 12 competitive categories in the FLL Robotics Championship. The team also took second highest, 13 missing first by a mere five points, in the robot mission category; and 14 WHEREAS, It is essential and fitting to recognize the triumphs of our youth and to

15 celebrate the accomplishments of our future leaders. The "Blockheads" are remarkable young 16 men. They exemplify everything that young people can achieve and they are truly deserving of 17 our recognition and praise; now, therefore be it
