It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-7.1 of the General Laws entitled "The Rhode Island Student 2 Investment Initiative" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 16-7.1-20. State aid to vocational education. -- (a) Notwithstanding any provision of 4 the general or public laws to the contrary, the general assembly shall appropriate annually a sum 5 equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the tuition and related educational costs for any and all students attending an elementary and/or secondary school which primarily provides vocational 6 7 and technological training and instruction. Said tuition and costs shall be paid from the general 8 fund directly to the vocational and technological school where the students are in attendance. In 9 the event a student commences, but does not complete a school year, the amount of said payments 10 shall be prorated. No city, town, and/or other municipality shall be required to make any 11 payments to any school, school district, and/or any other city, town, and/or municipality for 12 sending a student to such a vocational school. 13 The board of regents for elementary and secondary education shall promulgate rules and 14 regulations to govern the process by which vocational schools shall demonstrate the tuition and 15 costs for which payment is sought. 16 (b) The provisions of this section shall be applicable only to public elementary and 17 secondary schools for vocational and technological training and instruction maintenance and

- 1 section shall not apply to any vocational school currently maintained and/or operated by the board
- 2 of regents for elementary and secondary education.
- 3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
