It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 17-11-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-11 entitled "Voting
Districts and Officials" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 17-11-1. Division of towns and representative district into voting districts. -- The local board of any city or town may, on or before the sixtieth (60th) day preceding any election, 4 5 divide or redivide the town, or any representative district in the city or town, into voting districts. The local board of each city shall determine voting districts by geographical boundaries and by 6 7 no other means. No voting district shall at any time comprise parts of two (2) or more wards. It shall be the duty of the board to divide the town, representative district, or ward, so that 8 9 substantially not more than nineteen hundred (1900) three thousand (3,000) voters shall be served 10 by the same polling place; provided, that subject to the approval of the state board, a local board 11 may provide for serving more than nineteen hundred (1900) three thousand (3,000) voters in the 12 same polling place where the effect to the contrary would be of creating a polling place serving 13 less than one hundred fifty (150) two hundred (200) voters. A polling place may be located either 14 within or without the voting district for which it is established; provided, that a polling place may 15 be located outside the district only upon unanimous determination of the local board and subject 16 to the approval of the state board that a suitable place is not available within the voting district. In 17 making the calculation required by this section, voters whose names are on the inactive list of 18 voters shall not be included.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO ELECTIONS -- VOTING DISTRICTS AND OFFICIALS

1 This act would require a local board of canvassers to divide the town, representative 2 district, or ward into voting districts, to increase the size of voting districts from nineteen hundred 3 (1,900) voters to three thousand (3,000) voters to be served by the polling place, unless by 4 creating a polling place serving three thousand (3,000) voters it results in another voting district 5 that would serve less than two hundred (200) voters. 6 This act would take effect upon passage.
