It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-6-32 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-6 entitled "Electricians" is 2

5-6-32. Authority of director to assess penalty. -- (a) The director may assess an administrative penalty on any person, firm, or corporation for any violation of the provisions of this chapter, after notice and a hearing, before and upon the recommendation of the board of examiners of electricians in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500) one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for the first violation and nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) for a subsequent violation two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for the second (2nd) violation and five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the third (3rd) violation. The fourth (4th) violation will result in a suspension of license for twelve (12) months. The fifth (5th) violation will result in a suspension of license for twenty-four (24) months and board review for re-instatement. All funds collected by the labor and training department under this section shall be placed in the restricted receipts account created pursuant to section 28-22-1.1. This section is in addition to any other action provided by law for violations of this chapter.

(b) The chief of the section shall act as an investigator with respect to the enforcement of all the provisions of law relative to the licensing of electricians and, to this effect, whenever a complaint is made by the chief of the section to the director of the department of labor and training or his or her designee that the provisions of this chapter are being violated, the director of the department of labor and training or his or her designee may issue an order to cease and desist
