- 6 (2) Creation of a written guide for consumers relating to the rights and duties of landlords
- 7 and tenants pursuant to chapter 18 of title 34, which the secretary shall update at minimum on an
- 8 biennial basis. The guide shall be posted on the website of the department of housing and shall be
- 9 published in both English and Spanish.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2024.
