It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-4-51 of the General Laws in Chapter 36-4 entitled "Merit

2 System" is hereby repealed in its entirety:

3 <u>36-4-51. Running for elective office by classified employee. -- No classified employee</u>

or member of the personnel appeal board shall seek the nomination of or be a candidate for any

5 elective state office; neither shall any state elective officer be appointed a member of the

6 personnel appeal board or a classified employee unless he or she resigns his or her elective office.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
