1 RESOLVED, There is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not
2 otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year 2017-2018, the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000)
3 to the Rhode Island State Police Municipal Police Academy to implement law enforcement
4 mental health training for municipal police departments (not including Providence), sheriffs, and
5 capitol police; and the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon
6 the general treasurer for the payment of said sum, or so much thereof as may be from time
7 required, upon receipt of properly authenticated vouchers.
