CONGRATULATING STEVEN MORRONE ON BEING SELECTED AS RHODE ISLAND'S 2009-2010 "OUTSTANDING FIRST YEAR PRINCIPAL"

1 WHEREAS, "The future," in the wise words of Eleanor Roosevelt, "belongs to those 2 who believe in the beauty of their dreams." Since taking the helm in August of 2009, Steven 3 Morrone, Principal of Ashaway Elementary School, has inspired his staff and the school's 4 students to envision the possibilities and to believe that they can build a future full of promise; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, Principal Morrone is credited with transforming science education at 7 Ashaway Elementary School. In his first year as principal, he adopted a "common science 8 vocabulary," empowered students to feel confident about their science writing, and began 9 publishing a tri-yearly student science journal. These efforts produced significant and tangible 10 improvements. The student's New England Common Assessment Program (NECAP) test scores 11 in science amazingly rose from 42 percent to 75 percent proficiency in one year; and

WHEREAS, Described as a "mentor, a listener, a doer, and a builder of consensus among staff members," Principal Morrone has engaged and motivated both staff and students and has given parents the security of feeling safe leaving their children in the school's capable hands; and WHEREAS, Principal Morrone, a Westerly native, has also implemented a "school data wall," a student good deeds recognition program, and a school garden that produced 52 pounds of food for a local shelter; and

18 WHEREAS, Principal Morrone is a true and proven champion of education. He is a19 tremendous asset to Ashaway Elementary School and the entire school community. His genuine
