It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 28-27 of the General Laws entitled "Mechanical Trades" is hereby

2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

28-27-5.4. Work to be done by master pipefitters.-- (a) Notwithstanding the provision

4 of section 28-27-6.1 or any other provision of the general laws, only an individual holding a valid

5 <u>master pipefitter Class I license may purchase for installation in either a residential or commercial</u>

building a boiler or other heating unit of more than five hundred thousand British Thermal units

(500,000 BTUs) or a hot water heater that creates pressures of more than one hundred sixty

pounds per square inch (160 psi) and/or water temperature of greater than two hundred fifty

10 (b) Notwithstanding this provisions of section 28-27-6.1 or any other provision of the

general laws, only an individual holding a valid master pipefitter Class II license may purchase

for installation in either a residential or commercial building a boiler or other heating unit of less

than five hundred thousand British Thermal units (500,000 BTUs) or a hot water heater that

creates pressures of less than one hundred sixty pounds per square inch (160 psi) and/or water

15 <u>temperature of less than two hundred fifty (250°F) degrees Fahrenheit.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
