It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-2 of the General Laws entitled "School Committees and Superintendents" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

 16-2-35. City of Newport School dress code. -- The Newport school committee, in
- 4 conjunction with the superintendent, may adopt a school dress code for Newport elementary,
- 5 middle and high school students; provided, that:
- 6 (1) The principal, staff and parents have had an opportunity to offer suggestions and comments;
- 8 (2) The dress code shall be adopted at a time determined by the school committee, and
- 9 the school committee shall give notice to the parents at least three (3) months before a dress code
- 10 is required; and
- 11 (3) That on days when a nationally recognized youth organization has a scheduled
- 12 function, students participating in the organization shall be exempt from the dress code on that
- 13 <u>day.</u>
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
