It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title 45 of the General Laws entitled "TOWNS AND CITIES" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 **CHAPTER 69** 4 **COASTAL HAZARDS** 5 45-69-1. Coastal hazards applications. For purposes of coastal hazards, including sea level rise and coastal flooding, the state's 6 7 twenty-one (21) coastal communities are authorized to adopt the coastal resources management 8 council's (CRMC) coastal hazard application process applicable to a local overlay district bounded 9 by the seven foot (7') sea level rise, plus one hundred (100) year recurrence coastal storm as 10 specified by the CRMC's shoreline change special area management plan. This local overlay district 11 shall be for the purposes of assessing coastal hazardrisk of structures by applicants seeking building 12 permits. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 13
