It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-28.1 of the General Laws entitled "Fire Safety Code—General
- 2 Provisions is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>23-28.1-11. Applicability to highly congested structures.</u> Notwithstanding any
- 4 general or special law, statute, regulation, ordinance or rule to the contrary, and unless otherwise
- 5 specified, the provisions of this chapter shall only apply to buildings or structures that, in the
- 6 opinion of the fire marshal, or his or her designee within the division, are highly trafficked,
- 7 populated or congested and present a clear public safety risk, in accordance with guidelines
- 8 established by the fire marshal.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- FIRE SAFETY CODE--GENERAL PROVISIONS

1 This act would provide that the provisions of the state fire code shall only apply to buildings or structures that, in the opinion of the fire marshal are highly trafficked, populated or 2 3 congested and present a clear public safety risk, in accordance with guidelines established by the 4 fire marshal. 5

This act would take effect upon passage.
