It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37-14.1-6 of the General Laws in Chapter 37-14.1 entitled "Minority

Business Enterprise" is hereby amended to read as follows:

### 37-14.1-6. Minority business enterprise participation.

- (a) Minority business enterprises shall be included in all procurements and construction 4
- 5 projects under this chapter and shall be awarded a minimum of ten percent (10%) of the dollar
- 6 value of the entire procurement or project. The director of the department of administration is
- 7 further authorized to establish by rules and regulation the certification process and formulas for
- 8 giving minority business enterprises a preference in contract and subcontract awards.
- 9 (b) Any minority business enterprise currently certified by the U.S. Small Business
- 10 Administration as an 8(a) firm governed by 13 C.F.R. part 124 shall be deemed to be certified by
- 11 the department of administration as a minority business enterprise and shall only be required to
- 12 submit evidence of federal certification of good standing.
- 13 (c) The provisions of chapter 14.1 of title 37 shall not be waived, including, but not limited
- 14 to, during a declared state of emergency.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 15
