#### RELATING TO TOWNS AND CITIES - SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby
2	amended by adding thereto the following section:

- 3 <u>45-2-60. Secure communities program Participation. When the attorney general</u>
- 4 has signed a memorandum of understanding committing the state to participate in the secure
- 5 communities program as authorized by Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) provisions
- 6 regarding identification, detention arrest and removal of aliens (8 USC section 1226(c); 8 USC

7 section 1226(d); 8 USC section 1226(e); 8 USC section 1227(a)(2); and 8 USC section 1228); the

- 8 INA provision regarding liaison activities with internal security officers and data exchange (8
- 9 USC section 1105); and FY 2008 DHS Appropriations Act (Pub. L. No. 110-161, 121 Stat. 1844,
- 10 2365 (2007)), the provisions of the memorandum of understanding shall be binding upon the
- 11 several cities and towns, and no city or town shall, by ordinance, executive directive or otherwise,
- 12 seek to evade or opt out of its obligation to comply with the provisions of such memorandum of
- 13 <u>understanding</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
