6 **16-100-5. Reporting.** -- [School districts that have students participating in dual](#)
7 [enrollment programs shall report to the department of elementary and secondary education on an](#)
8 [annual basis regarding the number of students, the number of credits earned at postsecondary](#)
9 [institutions, the name of the institution, and the dollar amount the school district is allocated for](#)
10 [this program. The department of education shall provide the governor, president of the senate and](#)
11 [speaker of the house a report that shall contain the above information provided by district and in](#)
12 [the aggregate on an annual basis by October 31 of each year, commencing on October 31, 2014.](#)

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EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO EDUCATION

1 This act would require the board of education to prescribe by regulation a statewide dual
2 enrollment policy that would allow students to enroll in courses at postsecondary institutions to
3 satisfy academic credit requirements in both high school and the aforementioned postsecondary
4 institutions.

5 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
