It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-41.1-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-41.1 entitled

"Adjudication of Traffic Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>31-41.1-10. Expungement. --</u> All violations within this title which are in the jurisdiction

4 of the traffic tribunal or of a municipal court shall by operation of law, after three (3) five (5)

5 years, following adjudication of the violation and after expiration of any mandatory state or

federal record-retention period, be deleted from the records of the traffic tribunal or the municipal

court and from the records of the division of motor vehicles. These deletions shall be in addition

to and not in place of any expungement provided for by chapter 1.3 of title 12.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
