It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 16-2 of the General Laws entitled "School Committees and
2	Superintendents" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	<u>16-2-35. Criminal records background check review. – (a) The various local police</u>
4	departments of the state may offer to perform, free of charge, a state criminal records background
5	check for any person seeking to work with children in a civic, religious or youth organization;
6	provided said person submits a records release authorization.
7	(b) The police department performing the background check will examine the records of
8	the State of Rhode Island only, and shall respond to such request as having or not having
9	disqualifying information.
10	(c) An applicant against whom disqualifying information has been found may request that
11	a copy of the criminal background report be sent to the civic, religious, or youth organization who
12	shall make a judgment regarding the acceptability of the applicant.
13	(d) For purposes of this section, "disqualifying information" means those offenses listed
14	in section 23-17-37, and those offenses listed in sections 11-37-8.1 and 11-37-8.3.
15	(e) No police department performing these background checks shall be liable for the
16	omission of information in state files, or the lack of information in files of another state.
17	

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
