It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37-2-22 of the General Laws in Chapter 37-2 entitled "State

2 Purchases" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>37-2-22. Small purchases.</u>

- 4 Procurements, not to exceed an aggregate amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)
- 5 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for construction and five thousand dollars (\$5,000) ten
- 6 thousand dollars (\$10,000) for all other purchases may be made in accordance with small purchase
- 7 regulations promulgated by the chief purchasing officer. Procurement requirements shall not be

8 artificially divided so as to constitute a small purchase under this section.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on December 31, 2023.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROPERTY AND WORKS -- STATE PURCHASES

1 This act would provide that the maximum aggregate amounts for small purchases within 2 the chapter on state purchases be adjusted to not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for 3 construction and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for all other purchases.

4 This act would take effect on December 31, 2023.
