She was an 11 organizer of the Good Friday Walk and a participant for more than twenty-five years. She was 12 also the Parish Coordinator of the St Mary's Festival in Pawtucket, and was active in the Mother's 13 Club and the Legion of Mary. Additionally, she was a Girl Scout Leader and took great pleasure 14 in her work with them; and 15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Cardin leaves behind her granddaughter Tonimarie Donnell LaRose, 16 her grandson, Paul Bruscini, and her great grandchildren, Jeffrey and Caitlyn LaRose. She is also survived by her stepdaughter Katherine Devine, and her step- grandchildren, Meg Goldfaden, 17 18 Risa Cardin, and Alexander Cardin and many nieces and nephews. Pauline was the mother of the 19 late JoAnne Olson, and the sister of the late Vincent D'Angelo, Samuel D'Angelo, Charles

D'Angelo, Joseph D'Angelo, Jr., Frances DeMartino and Eleanor Grasso. She also leaves behind
