It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31-46-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-46 entitled "Rhode Island
 Salvage Law" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>31-46-1. Duty of insurance company.</u>
- 4 (a) Any insurance company taking possession of a motor vehicle for which a certificate of
 5 title has been issued in this state, that has been declared a total loss because of damage to that
 6 vehicle, in settlement of a claim for damage or theft shall within ten (10) days deliver to the division
 7 of motor vehicles the certificate of title of that vehicle and obtain a salvage certificate of title for
 8 that vehicle as prescribed for by the administrator of the division of motor vehicles.
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on a power of attorney or other
- 10 document supporting an application for a certificate of ownership or salvage certificate of title by
- 11 an insurer or an agent of an insurer, the signature or electronic signature of the owner who has
- 12 received or is to receive a total loss settlement from the insurer shall not require notarization.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
