It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 39-14.1-6 of the General Laws in Chapter 39-14.1 entitled "Public

Motor Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 39-14.1-6. Operations of public motor vehicles. -- No public motor vehicle shall be

operated from any taxicab stand on any public highway; nor shall the operator of it transport any

5 passenger for hire unless the transportation is requested by the passenger at an office of the owner

of the vehicle, either personally or by telephone and/or other electronic means. When solicited by

a prospective customer the certificate holder or its representative shall quote what the actual rate

8 or fee charge for the requested transportation service will be prior to picking up the passenger(s).

9 The division of public utilities and carriers shall establish and set a minimum allowable charge

for public motor vehicle services; provided, however, that such minimum charge shall be no less

than thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per trip.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
