It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37-2-12 of the General Laws in Chapter 37-2 entitled "State

Purchases" is hereby amended to read as follows:

37-2-12. Centralization of the procurement authority. -- All rights, powers, duties, and

authority relating to the procurement of supplies, services, and construction, and the management,

control, warehousing, sale, and disposal of supplies, services, and construction now vested in or

exercised by any state agency under the several statutes relating thereto are hereby transferred to

7 the chief purchasing officer as provided in this chapter, subject to the provisions of section 37-2-

8 54. A public agency does not have to utilize the centralized purchasing of the state but the public

agency, through its existing internal purchasing function, shall adhere to the general principles,

policies and practices set forth in this chapter. The chief purchasing officer shall not delegate to

11 the Rhode Island department of transportation any purchasing authority to enter into binding

contract amendments on behalf of the state, except for purchases made pursuant to section 37-2-

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROPERTY AND WORKS - STATE PURCHASES

1 This act would prohibit the state purchasing officer from delegating to the department of transportation any purchasing authority to enter into a binding contract on behalf of the state 2 3 except in the case of small purchases not exceeding ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). 4 This act would take effect upon passage. LC02481
