| 3  | WHEREAS, Clifford T. Gardner was born in South Kingstown, the son of Clifford T.                 |
| 4  | Gardner and Mary Gardner. He served in the Rhode Island State Senate from 1944 to 1947 before    |
| 5  | he left to join the United States Navy. Clifford served his nation for twenty-seven years with   |
| 6  | honor, valor, and integrity. He retired in 1974 as a Chief Petty Officer; and                    |
| 7  | WHEREAS, Clifford, after retiring from the United States Navy, worked for twenty-one             |
| 8  | years as an Environmental Police Officer for the Rhode Island Department of Environmental        |
| 9  | Management. He retired from the State of Rhode Island in 1990; and                               |
| 10 | WHEREAS, Clifford was a lifelong resident of South County and worked for many years              |
| 11 | as a Pastoral Assistant at the Church of the Ascension. He was a coach with American Legion      |
| 12 | Baseball for thirty-five years, a member of the American Legion Post 39, and served the          |
| 13 | American Legion in variety of capacities, including past commander for fourteen years, Chaplain, |
| 14 | and service officer. Clifford is a member of the American Legion Hall of Fame, was the President |
| 15 | of the USS Tarawa, and was a member of Hope Lodge #25 AF & FM; and                               |
| 16 | WHEREAS, Clifford was the father of Carl E. Gardner, the stepfather of Steven Kile,              |
| 17 | Alex Martlano-Kile, and the late Eric Kile and Debra Jean Gardner-Clarke, and the brother of     |
| 18 | Norman Gardner, Glenn Gardner, Marilyn Barrington, Betty Rocha, Joyce Dias, and the late         |
| 19 | Harry Gardner and Franklin Gardner. Clifford was he grandfather of seven and the great-          |
