Russell was also the brother of the late Bertha Mauricio, Walter Reis, Lois Gomes, 6 Kenneth Reis, and Joyce Waters, godfather of Roxanne Archibald, Cheryl Archibald Bennett, and 7 8 Brandi Venter, and uncle to many dear nieces and nephews. 9 WHEREAS, Born in 1950 to the late Dorothy and Roy Archibald, Russell grew up in the 10 city of Providence, Rhode Island; and 11 WHEREAS, Russell built a long and distinguished career focused on giving back to 12 others. In the 1970's he served as the Assistant Superintendant of the Rhode Island Training 13 School. He was a civil rights attorney in Boston for the Department of Housing and Urban 14 Development for over twenty years, and he also worked at Model Cities in Providence; and 15 WHEREAS, Russell also donated his time to the causes he cherished. He was a long time 16 member of the International Bar Association, the Fox Point Boys & Girls Club, and the Sheldon 17 Street Church; and 18 WHEREAS, Russell was an enthusiastic traveler who enjoyed bowling and the game of 19 Blackjack; and
