After being discharged, he was employed as a Railroad Police Officer and in 1967 became a Rhode Island State Police Officer until his retirement in 1992; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Never one to remain idle, Chief Driscoll began working as a security 12 consultant for the Flatley Company until being recruited to serve as Chief of the Richmond Police 13 Department in December of 1993; and WHEREAS, Chief Driscoll's dedication to excellence in his profession led to vast 14 15 improvements within the police department. The once part-time department became a professional full-time agency with 24/7 coverage. He was also able to procure grant monies to 16 train and equip his officers and establish a resource officer program in the local high school; and 17 WHEREAS, Chief Driscoll is described by friends and colleagues as a "cop's cop" and a 18

"man's man." His "no-nonsense approach" and "innate powers of observation" have not only
