It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20-4-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 20-4 entitled "Commercial

Fisheries" is hereby amended to read as follows:

20-4-1. Commercial fishing. -- No person shall engage in the taking for sale by any

manner, method, or contrivance of any marine finfish, shellfish, crustacean, or other invertebrate;

and no vessel, boat, trap, seine, or other fishing gear shall be used in the taking for sale or landing 5

of any marine finfish, shellfish, crustacean, or other invertebrate unless a license or permit has

been obtained as provided in this title. Provided, however, that for all commercial fisheries except 7

shellfish, any number of unlicensed crews may assist in direct commercial harvest operations 8

regardless of the manner, method or contrivance employed, as long as said crew is/are operating

10 under the direct supervision of a properly licensed individual in command of a commercially

11 declared vessel. With respect to commercial shellfish operations, an unlicensed crew may only

12 assist with culling activities and other indirect harvest operations while under the direct

13 supervision of a properly licensed individual in command of a commercially declared vessel.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO FISH AND WILDLIFE -- COMMERCIAL FISHERIES

This act would provide that, except for shellfish, an unlicensed crew may assist in direct commercial operations for commercial fisheries as long as the crew is supervised by a properly licensed individual in command of a commercially declared vessel. This act would further provide that with respect to shellfish operations, an unlicensed crew may only assist with supervised culling and indirect harvest operations.

This act would take effect upon passage.
