1 SECTION 1. Chapter 22-7.4 of the General Laws entitled "Permanent Joint Committee

on Naming All New Buildings, Bridges, Edifices and Other State Constructions" is hereby

4 <u>22-7.4-112. Leslie Cameron Greenhouse.</u> – The greenhouse building located at Rhode

5 <u>Island College, 600 Mt. Pleasant Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island, shall hereafter be named and</u>

6 known as the "Leslie Cameron Greenhouse" in honor of Leslie Cameron, Rhode Island College

7 Class of 1970, who provided funding for the renovation of this facility.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
